During the month of March, the children enjoyed doing St. Patrick and Easter activities. I made a St. Patrick's Day sensory box during the month of March and added gold coins and cups. Green grass and eggs was added, and the gold coins were left in the sensory box for them to put in the eggs.

We painted a shamrock green for St. Patrick's Day. The children stamped bunnies and eggs on their paper for Easter. During the month of March, we also concentrated on colors. I have color pom poms and the children would name the colors and get to put the pom poms in a cup. We worked on our fine motor skills by using a pair of tongs to pick the pom poms up to put them in a cup. Everyone loved this activity.

During the month of April, we will be discussing Spring. We will be reading books on spring. We had so much fun with both sensory boxes that we made that we've decided to make one for our Spring theme. We will be making a bug sensory box which we will add bugs. We will also do a water sensory and make a pond. The children will add frogs and ducks to our pond.



The children will be painting rain drops because it does rain in the spring. They love to lace beads on a piece of string, so we will be doing that to work on their fine motor during the month of April. To go along with our rain drops, we will be making paper plate umbrellas. We will paint the umbrellas. The children will also be painting a sun to show how it is warming up in the spring.

When we go outside to play, we are going to be looking at the trees to see how they have changed now that it is spring. We are going to look and see if the leaves on the trees are growing back. The children love to explore the playground to see what kinds of bugs they can find. We love to get the sidewalk chalk out now that it is warmer and draw on the sidewalk.
