Monthly teacher tips:



VPK I

Welcome Spring! Spring is here and our class has a lot of exciting things to learn! It is hard to believe that we only have three more months left of VPK. The children in the first week of March will start learning all about Lent. We will explore and discuss what is Lent and why we practice it. We also will be advancing deeper into Lent through Sister Donna with church, and, in our unit, through "Discovering Gods world"

We will be learning about Saint Patrick and celebrating the day. We will discuss Who is Saint Patrick? What was Saint Patrick known for, and where did he come from? We will read many books about Saint Patrick and create many art projects that reflect this holiday and Saint.

Metamorphosis~ the biological process by which an animal physically develops after birth or hatching through the stages of development

We'll continue our study of Authors and Illustrators by celebrating Dr. Seuss Birthday. We will be reading his books and using all his rhyming words. We will have art that reflects Dr. Seuss stories. We will be covering Eric Carle books and the "Very Hungry Caterpillar" and "Brown Bear, Brown Bear". Along with this, we will add to science the study of the stages of a caterpillar. We would like the children to understand the term "Metamorphosis". This is the biological process by which an animal physical develops after birth or hatching through the stages of development. Our class will be discussing all about plants and insects. We each will be growing a little plant, this helps children understand the soil, seed, plant process.

The Early Childhood Development Domains that we are targeting for March are language and literacy development, cognition and general Knowledge. (Science), and approaches toward learning.

I would also like to remind families that our class is still learning about other countries and we are continuing to write to Michael Drago from the US Marines currently stationed in Colombo, Sri Lanka. The children are enjoying getting to know him. They are getting an awareness globally and an understanding of what Men and Women do in uniform. During our Circle time and along with our morning lessons of numbers, letters and sounds, Miss Riley goes over sign language with the children. Miss Riley is brilliant and the children love her as much as I do.

February was filled with love in our class room. The children enjoyed passing out Valentine cards to all of their friends and teachers and making cards for their families and friends. We had a great party. Thank you so much for your donations and gifts. We really appreciate everything you do for us.

March brings us the season of spring and the Holy season of Lent. March 6TH is *Ash_Wednesday*, the beginning of our Holy Season of Lent. Lent is a period of time between Ash Wednesday and Easter. Well in to the Holy Season of Lent, we are reminded of the ongoing need all of us have for conversion.

During Lent, we try to work extra hard at being the best we can be by doing good works for others, sharing, praying, and trying to do what is right at home and at school. Each week we will add a different symbol around our cross and say a different prayer. These will help us focus on our journey to Easter.

We will discuss about the greatness of Jesus love for each one of us. Our big question will be what can we do to show our **Love** for **JESUS**?

We will begin a Unit on **Authors and Illustrators** by celebrating **Dr. Seuss' Birthday**. During this week we will read some of his books and practice our rhyming words, and enjoy Green Eggs and Ham. **Lois Elhert and Pat Hutchings** are a couple of the other authors and illustrators we will explore during this study. **When the Doorbell Rang, Rosie's Walk, Ten Little Caterpillars and Eating the Alphabet** are just a few of their titles we will be reading. These wonderful books offer us lessons on addition and subtraction as well as predicting the outcome in a story. **Laura Numeroff** and her books on "**If you give a**..." help us learn about making predictions and look for the outcome in all of our activities.

We will use some of the books by *Eric Carle* to help us practice our sequencing and days of the week with the book *Very Hungry Caterpillar* and review our color words with *Brown Bear*, *Brown Bear*. We will also taste our way through the week as we follow the Very Hungry Caterpillar on his journey. And we will discuss how a Caterpillar Becomes a Butterfly?

This month is going to be a lot of fun with our puppets, dramatic play, special art and crafts, songs, finger plays and cooking activities.

We will continue our learning by making patterns, Math activities for building Number sense to 1-20, Counting down numbers from 10-0, addition to 5, Learning Alphabet letter, sound and brainstorm to find the words that begin that letter sound, rhymes, sight words and Compound words.

We will be focusing on getting ready for Kindergarten. If you have any questions about your child and their readiness, please feel free to ask. We feel so blessed to be on this journey with you and your children.

March 18 to 25 –No VPK. Please come for our Lenten Fish Fry's which will be on March 8th, 22nd and April 5th.

I hope that you have a beautiful month and I look forward to seeing everyone at the Fish Fry's!! Blessings,


