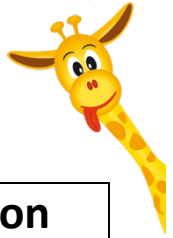


Peek at Our Week



Standard Focus	Activity	Home Extension Activity
Demonstrates increasing precision, strength, coordination and efficiency when using hand muscles for play and functional tasks.	Use our pool to put red and green tissue paper in and the children can get in the pool to use their hands to crumple the tissue paper.	Use tissue paper at home and put on some music for your child to dance to with the tissue paper.
Begins to participate in own family practices (traditions, celebrations, songs, food or language), Responds to simple requests.	Have the parent's pack an item in their child's lunch box that they might only enjoy eating during the holiday season.	At home make a special treat that the family enjoys eating during the holiday season.
Shows curiosity in different forms of artistic expression (e.g. music, art, and dance)	Use our bells and other instruments to sing and dance to our Christmas music.	Put Christmas music on and let your child dance and this will allow your child to express themselves.
