Food and Nutrition- The Children will be making “dirt in a cup” (chocolate pudding, crushed Oreo cookies and gummy worms. The children will be taught to use good table manners while eating and the importance of eating their growing food first and to save snack items for last or for snack time. Discussion at lunch of healthy food choices is a daily occurrence. Children will be encouraged to describe how their food taste, tangy, sweet, savory, etc. Standards: I.A.c.,d.

Learning Centers:

Blocks: Building resurrection scene, The tomb, the Easter story. With blocks and paper tubes. D.4

Dramatic Play- Setting up the table with plates, cups and flatware. Roll play- “The Last supper” D.1

Library Area- Language and Literacy Development: puppets, Flannel Stories, The Easter Story. IV.F.1.b
