We will be talking about the disabilities that some people can have with their hearing. We will talk about different devices that can be used to help them hear and for those that devices won't work we use sign language. We will teach them a few simple phrases using sign language, such as hello, how are you, thank you, etc

Attached is the ASL alphabet. Use the ASL alphabet to teach your child how to sign their name!
