For art this week, we will set up several colors of paint, adding rice, flour, glitter, sand or other things to each color to give each one its own texture. Then allow the children to use the paint to finger paint.</p>	<p>Let your child touch their different foods and explain how they feel different. Are they smooth, rough, sticky or bumpy?</p>

Then we will talk about how the different textures feel on their feet.</p>	<p>Let your child walk in the yard in their bare feet to feel the grass and different sensations on their feet.</p>

Discuss with your child what kind of consequences your child has at home for their poor choices.</p>
